2. This Procurement notice includes the terms and conditions applicable to submission of bids; criteria for qualification, evaluation, and for award of work order(s); and relevant forms to be filled by the bidders.

4. Bids, both Technical Part and Financial Part shall be submitted on or before 14:00 hours on **18<sup>th</sup> February 2026** and must be accompanied by a Bid Security of **Rs. 1.70 Lakh**. Any bid or modifications to bid received after the deadline shall not be considered and returned unopened.
5. The sealed envelope should be super scribed as “Renovation of Conference Hall at Aranya Bhawan including supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Audio-Visual and conferencing systems”; “Not to be opened before **18<sup>th</sup> February 2026** at 14.30 hours”.

### 1) Scope of Work:

The Project Director, APFBC Society invites bid for renovation work as detailed in the table given below:

- Each bidder shall submit only one bid and 3D design, video & drawing.
- Bidders shall not contact other Bidders on matters relating to this bid.

- e) The bidder is required to submit the bid in two distinct parts: the Technical Bid and the Financial Bid. The Technical Bid must include all relevant technical documents along with the signed copy of the bidding document. The Financial Bid should contain the Letter of Bid (Financial) and the priced Bill of Quantities. Both parts then should be put in an outer envelope for submission clearly marked as '**Bid for Renovation of Conference Hall at Aranya Bhawan including supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Audio-Visual and conferencing systems.**'
- f) The name of the bidder, address and contact no. should be mentioned on the reverse of the sealed envelope.
- g) All pages of the bid shall be signed and stamped by the authorized person to indicate that the bidder has agreed to all terms and conditions of the bid.
- h) Overwriting, alterations, if any, in the bid should be signed by the authorized signatory.
- i) Bid not accompanied by specified documents, self-declarations, signatures may be rejected by the office as non-responsive and may not be evaluated.

**4) Pre-Bid Site Visit:** Prospective bidders/vendors are encouraged to visit the project site at Aranya Bhawan, Conference Hall and associated areas to understand the site conditions, project scope, and seek clarifications before submitting their bids. The Pre-Bid site visit shall be conducted on **9<sup>th</sup> February 2026** and **10<sup>th</sup> February 2026** between 03:00 PM and 04:00 PM. Bidders may attend personally or send an authorized representative and are requested to carry relevant identification and documents, if required. Requests for site visits outside the scheduled dates will not be entertained.

**5) Clarifications:** Any request for clarification regarding this bid shall be sent in writing to office of the Project Director, PMU, APFBCS, Aranya Bhawan, Panjabari, Guwahati - 781037 (Assam), Email: [pd@apfbc.in](mailto:pd@apfbc.in) no later than 5:00 pm on **12<sup>th</sup> February 2026**. Responses will be provided, and if necessary, an addendum or corrigendum will be issued, which shall form an integral part of the tender.

**6) Bid Prices:**

- a) The bid shall be for the entire scope of AV system and interior works as specified in the Bill of Quantities.
- b) Corrections, if any, in the bid shall be carried out by editing the information before submission.
- c) The rates quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the contract period and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- d) The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

**7) Bid Security**

- a) The bidder shall furnish, as part of their bid, a bid security in the amount specified in the detailed IFB for this particular work. The bid security shall be in favor of the 'Assam Project on Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society Phase II,' payable at Guwahati, Assam, in one of the following forms:
- Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) or Term Deposit Receipt (TDR) issued by Nationalized/Schedule Bank in India.; or
  - Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized/Schedule Bank in India.
- b) The Bid Security must remain valid for forty-five (45) days beyond the original or extended validity period of the bid.
- c) Any bid not accompanied by an acceptable Bid security shall be rejected by the Employer as non-responsive.
- d) Unless there is any challenge on the bid/bid process in any court of law, the Bid security of unsuccessful bidders will be returned within 28 days of the end of the validity period.
- e) The bid Security of the Successful Bidder will be discharged when the bidder has signed the Agreement and furnished the Performance Security.
- f) The Bid security shall be forfeited

- i. If the Bidder withdraws the Bid after Bid Opening during the period of Bid Validity;
- ii. If the Bidder does not accept the correction of the Bid Price, pursuant to Clause 15; or
- iii. In the case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails within the specified time limit to:
  - Sign the Agreement.
  - Or furnish the required Performance Security.

**8) The Technical bid shall comprise the following:**

- b) Bid document Sealed & Signed by the authorized bidder.
- c) Bid Security

- e) Evidence in accordance with Clause 2 establishing Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract, if its bid is accepted.
- f) The Technical bid shall not include any financial information related to the Bid price. Where material financial information related to the Bid price is contained in the Technical Part of Bid, the Bid shall be declared non-responsive.

**9) The Financial bid shall comprise the following:**

- a) Letter of Bid- Financial Part
- b) Priced Bill of Quantities.

**10) Signing of Bids:** The name and position held by each person signing the bid and related documents must be typed or printed below the signature.

**11) Deadline for Submission of Bids (with 3D designs, video and drawings):** Bids along with 3D designs, video and drawings must be submitted no later than the deadline for submission of bids viz. 14.00 hours on **18<sup>th</sup> February 2026**. A Bidder may modify its bid any number of times before the deadline for submission of bids.

**12) Validity of Bid:** Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 90 (Ninety) days after the deadline date specified for submission.

**13) Bid Submission:** Bidders may submit their sealed envelopes containing the bids by post or by hand or drop in the box earmarked by the Employer.

**14) Opening and Evaluation of the Bids -Technical:**

- a) The Technical bids will be opened publicly on the specified date and time wherein willing bidders may remain present.
- b) The Employer shall examine the bid to determine whether the bid -
  - i. has been properly signed and properly designed;
  - ii. is substantially responsive to the requirements of the bidding document; and
  - iii. meets the qualification criteria specified.

**15) Evaluation Criteria:** Bidders will be evaluated on financial capability, relevant experience in AV/conferencing and interior works, post-completion responsibility/maintenance, and the quality of 3D design and drawings, with special emphasis on the design and drawings. The maximum technical score is 100 marks, and bidders must score at least **75 marks (75%)** to qualify for the financial bid stage. Marking for each element and the qualifying criteria set forth herein shall be assigned **internally by the evaluation committee**.

**The minimum technical score (TS) required to pass is: 75**

**Note: Bidders are required to fulfill all the conditions specified in Clause 2 of Section-I (Qualification Criteria). Failure to meet any one of the conditions or not obtaining a minimum score of 75 out of 100 in the technical evaluation shall render the bidder ineligible for financial evaluation.**

#### **14) Opening and Evaluation of the Bids -Financial**

- a) The Financial bids will be opened on the specified date and time by the employer's evaluation committee in the presence of the representatives of those bidders whose bids have passed the minimum technical score.
- b) The committee shall examine and confirm that Letter of bid – Financial Part and Priced Bill of Quantities are in accordance with the requirements specified in the bidding document. If any of these documents or information is missing, the offer shall be rejected.
- c) During the evaluation of Financial bid, the substantial responsiveness of the bids will be further determined with respect to those bidding document conditions that were not examined in evaluation of Technical bids.

#### **15) Award of contract:**

- a) The Employer will award the contract to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated bid price.
- b) Notwithstanding the above, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any bids and to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of contract.
- c) Normal commercial warranty/ guarantee shall be applicable to the supplied goods.
- d) The bidder whose bid is accepted will be notified of the award of contract by the Employer prior to expiration of the bid validity period.

#### **16) Adjustment:**

- a) Any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) shall be re-computed by the APFBC Society.
- b) The unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, in case of any discrepancy.
- c) If the bidder does not accept the final price based on re-computation and correction of errors, its bid will be rejected and the bid security will be forfeited.

#### **17) Liquidated Damages:**

- a) Liquidated damages shall be imposed to the selected bidder under the following conditions:
  - i. Non-completion of work under the contract beyond thirty (30) days from the date of the award of the Work Order shall invite **0.5%** liquidated damage per day of the total contract value.
  - ii. The liquidated damage shall be calculated upto a maximum of 10% of the total contract amount. Next course of action once the maximum percentage is reached shall be termination of the contract under the bid.

#### **18) Payments:**

- a) Payment shall be made on submission of bills/invoices along with the requisite supporting documents and certification by the concerned officer of the APFBC Society.
- b) All payments to the successful bidder shall be made by Account Transfer only.
- c) All taxes (including GST, etc.) shall be dealt with as per the Govt. laws



- d) **No advance payment** shall be made.

#### 19) Performance Security

- a) Within 7 days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the successful bidder shall deliver to the Employer a performance security, in the form provided in Section III, for an amount equivalent to 5% (five percent) of the contract price.
- b) The performance security should be pledged in favor of the 'Assam Project on Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society Phase II,' payable at Guwahati, Assam.
- c) The validity of the performance security shall be for a period of 45 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations.
- d) Failure of the successful bidder to submit the aforementioned Performance Security shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award of contract and forfeiture of the bid security.

#### 20) Provision for Variations

Any variation in the scope of works, including but not limited to additions, alterations, or substitutions, shall be permitted only upon prior written approval of the Project Director, APFBC Society. Such variations shall be executed based on approved specifications and certified measurements, and payments shall be made on actuals as per the applicable rates or as determined by the competent authority in accordance with the terms of the contract. No variation shall be deemed authorized unless expressly approved in writing.

#### 21) Insurance and Safety

- a) The Contractor shall ensure the safety of all workers, tools, and equipment on site and shall be **solely responsible for any accidents, injuries, or damages** occurring during the execution of work.
- b) The Contractor is advised to maintain appropriate **insurance coverage** for personnel, equipment, and third-party liability for the entire duration of the project.

#### 22) Compliance with Laws

The Contractor shall strictly adhere to all **applicable laws, by-laws, rules, and regulations** of local, state, and central governments including those related to **labour, safety, environment, and construction standards**.

#### 23) Sub-contracting

The Contractor **shall not sub-contract** the whole or any part of the work without **prior written approval** of the Employer. In case of violation, the Employer reserves the right to terminate the contract.

#### 24) Force Majeure

Neither party shall be held responsible for any delay or failure in performance due to **events beyond their control**, such as natural disasters, war, strikes, or government orders. In such cases, the timeline for completion may be **extended** suitably, subject to Employer's approval.

#### 25) Termination Clause

- (a) The Employer may terminate the contract **with 15 days' written notice** if the Contractor:
  - Fails to perform any obligations,
  - Abandons the work, or
  - Is involved in corrupt or fraudulent practices.
- (b) Upon termination, the Employer shall pay only for the **portion of the work completed** and certified up to the date of termination.

#### 26) Confidentiality

The Contractor shall not disclose any information or documentation related to the work or the project to any third party **without written consent** of the Employer.

#### 27) Ownership of Materials

All materials, equipment, and documents paid for by the Employer shall become the property of the Employer, and the Contractor shall not remove them from the site without permission.

## **28) Dispute Resolution**

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved through mutual consultation. If unresolved, the matter shall be referred to arbitration under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended. The venue of arbitration shall be **Guwahati**, Assam.

## **29) Miscellaneous:**

- a) APFBC Society is not bound to accept any bid, nor award a contract/work order, nor be responsible for any costs associated with supplier's preparation and submission of bid, regardless of the outcome or the manner of conducting the selection process.
- b) Areas where job is performed, should be left neat and clean after the completion of the job. All waste material should be taken away and disposed off by the bidder.
- c) No variation or modification of the terms and conditions of the contract shall be made.
- d) All materials and workmanship shall be of branded/superior quality and shall be subjected to inspection. Should the specification does not match highest standard, the Employer may reject them and the supplier shall replace the item(s) to meet specification requirement free of cost to the Purchaser.
